


Boat Hardware

The 4 Nuts

Wing nuts are are WING hand tightened and used on the foot stretchers. NYLOCK



Hex and square nuts are used throughout the boat. SQUARE



Washers


Flat washers are used FLAT for protection, and are placed first


onto the bolt.

Lock washers secure. LOCK and are placed onto the bolt second, followed by a nut.


A Quick Note...


European shells use 10 millimeter hardware, and U.S. shells use 7/16 inch hardware. The difference is slight, but one must always remember to pack the correct tools for their boat.
